

Note: The wide end of the Spring should be closer to the Spring storage area where the Spring is held when compressed (some CLIX models have the storage area in the Cup, some have it in the Cam Follower. The drawing above shows a model in which the wide end of the spring is stored in the Cup).

Not all forks work with a CLIX quick release. Therefore, Dealers should not swap wheels between a CLIX equipped bike and a non-CLIX equipped bike. Once the CLIX wheel is set for the bike it came with, it should not be used with any other bike.

With initial CLIX QR installation and adjustment having been done by the Dealer the consumer receives their bike with CLIX in the correct adjusted condition and does not have to readjust their QR each time they remove and install their front wheel. Now that the Dealer has correctly adjusted CLIX and it is time for the Dealer to instruct the consumer how to operate CLIX. Dealers should educate customers, as always, on correct quick release operation and encourage their customers to check in with the Dealer periodically to confirm correct function of all parts. Dealers should also make sure consumers understand not to swap a CLIX wheel to another bike.

This is a new system and it is therefore especially important that the Dealer does not remove the hangtag from the QR. The Dealer should review the hangtag with the consumer at time of purchase. Once the Dealer has properly adjusted CLIX, no quick release adjustment is required each time the wheel is removed and installed. The rider can operate the CLIX quick release from one side of the bike by using only one hand.
